## Guidelines in Filling-Up Catch Origin Landing Declaration (COLD)

The master/captain of the landing vessel, canner/entity/cold storage authorized representative, port manager and BFAR Fisheries Officer are requested to fill-up the COLD in accordance with the following guidelines:

Box No.	Description	Responsible Person
1. Name of Landing/Unloading Vessel	Indicate the name of the landing vessel in reference to the registration paper and fishing license.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
2. Registration Number and License Number	The registration number issued by the Flag State in reference to the vessel's registration paper and the fishing license number in reference to the vessel's fishing license.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
3. Owner	The name of the owner of the fishing vessel. (e.g. Certificate of Ownership for PH FV)	BFAR Fisheries Officer
4. Flag	The country or Flag State from which the fishing vessel is registered to.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
5. Vessel Type	The type of landing vessel, whether catcher or carrier/reefer carrier.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
6. Transshipment Certificate/Mate's Receipt/FODF Reference Number	The reference number of the Transshipment Certificate/Mate's Receipt/Fish Origin Declaration Form.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
7. Port/Place Landed	The name of the fishport and location where the catch was landed.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
8. Source of Catch (Name of catcher vessel, flag and logsheet reference number)	The name and flag of the catcher vessel where the catch originated and the logsheet reference number of the logsheet covering the said catch.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
9. Date/s Landed/Unloaded (From/To)	The date/s when the catch was landed.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
10. Species	The species of fish landed (use species codes at the bottom left box)	BFAR Fisheries Officer
11. Catch Description	The description of catch landed whether fresh/chilled, frozen, fillet/loin and others.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
12. Verified Weight Landed (in kilograms)	The actual weight/quantity of fish landed, in kilograms.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
13. Buyer/Destination	The country of destination or the name of cannery/entity/cold storage, whichever is applicable, where the landed catch was sold/supplied to.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
14. Inspected/Verified by:	The name, signature and seal of the BFAR Fisheries Officer who inspected the fishing vessel and verified the landed catch.	BFAR Fisheries Officer
